For more than 20 years, Toner Group has invested heavily in it's people.

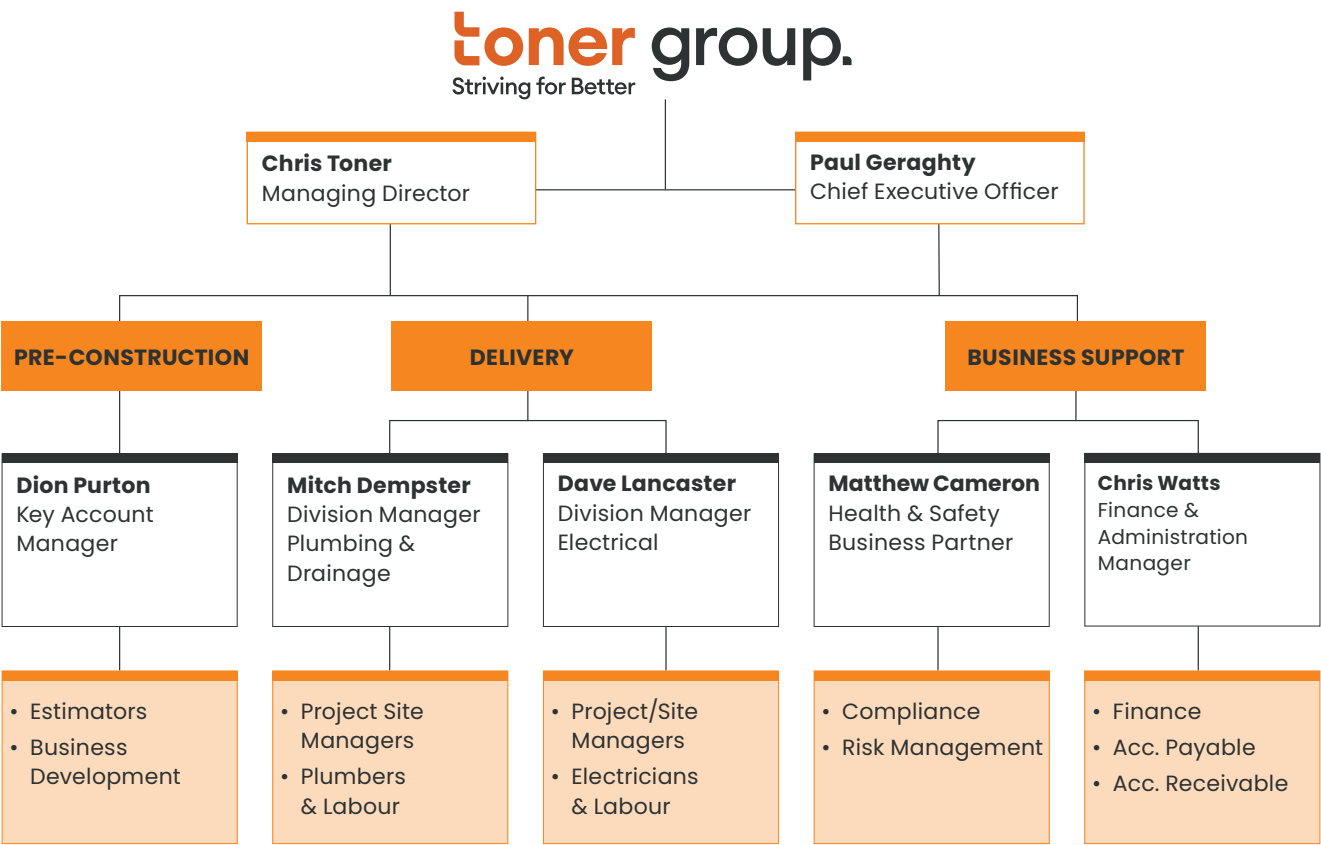

Scope of Works:

Partnered with PreBuilt Pty Ltd delivering the plumbing and civil drainage scope of work associated with the construction of a 23-apartment modular construction complex built over three (3) levels for the Rich River Golf Club on the VIC / NSW boarder (Moama, NSW). The project was for stage 1 with a further 15 apartment complex to follow in stage 2 with a total of 38 apartments once both stages are completed.

Works included:

- Internal plumbing and hydraulic water/waste rough-in to 23 apartments;
- Services run through a central hydraulic shaft;
- All waste pipework sound lagged;
- Bathroom fixtures installed off-site (modular construction);
- Internal downpipes within service voids;
- Below-ground sewer, stormwater, and fire services installed prior to building placement;
- Onsite connection and commissioning of accommodation modules;
- Installation and commissioning of hot water systems.

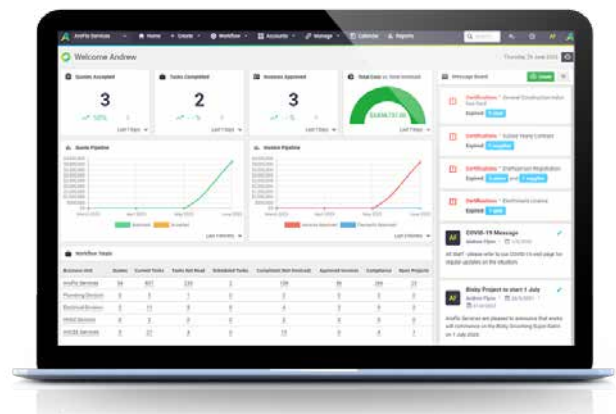
